SR 1 CONGESTION AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Project Overview

The SR 1 Congestion & Safety Improvements Project aims to improve traffic flow and safety within the project area, which includes three major intersections: SR 1/16th Street, SR 1/California Avenue, and SR 1/Cypress Avenue. The project aims to improve safety and accessibility for drivers, cyclists, pedestrians, and transit riders, with careful consideration given to preserving the character of Moss Beach’s unique coastal community.

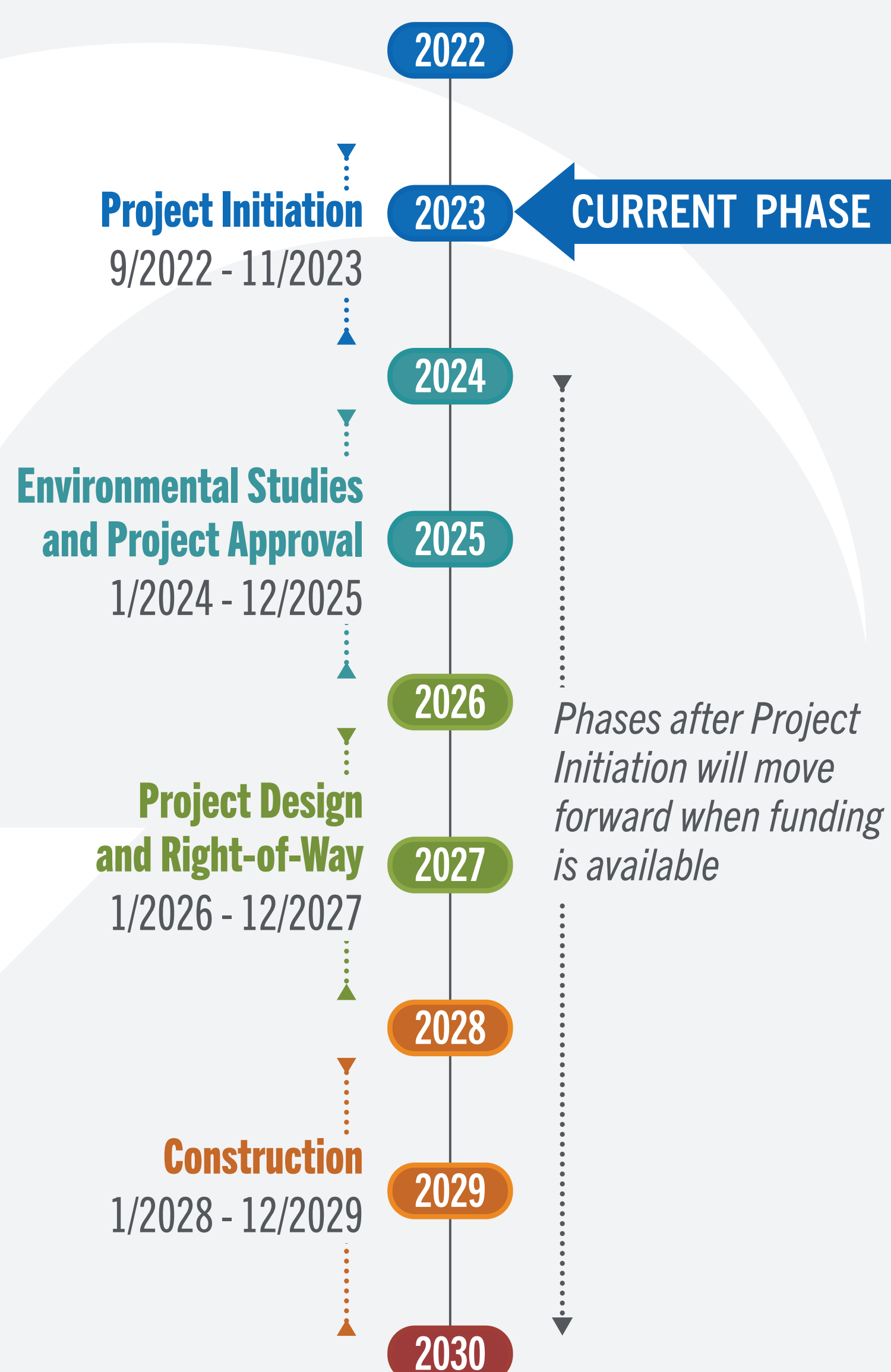
By taking a balanced approach that considers both transportation needs and the local environment, the project represents a significant step towards enhancing mobility, safety, and livability for all residents.



Timeline & Project Funding

The SR 1 Congestion & Safety Improvements Project is currently in the Project Initiation phase. Over the next few years, it will progress through an environmental review and into the design phase, before ultimately culminating in construction.

The Project Initiation phase is funded by the San Mateo County Transportation Authority Measure W and matching County funds.
