An Update on Suicides in San Mateo County

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
Overview

- Suicides in San Mateo County increased 24% from 2021 to 2022, while suicides in California increased 3% from 2021 to 2022
- Suicides in SMC decreased 3% in 2023 compared to 2022
- Not any overarching reason(s) for the changes; many subtrends occurring




Number of Suicides in San Mateo County, 2014-2023

---Number of Suicides






Rate of Suicides in San Mateo County and CA, 2013-2022






Suicides in San Mateo County by Month, 2019-2023

Increasing trend among females from 2021-2023



Suicides by Age Group, SMC, 2019-2023



Numbers have been increasing for 61-70 year olds.

Numbers are small for youth aged 11-20.

Individuals 65 and older have the highest rates.





SMC suicides tend to skew older than CA suicides.



Suicides by Race/Ethnicity, SMC, 2019-2023



Most suicides occur among White individuals, followed by Asians. Whites have the highest rates.



About 65% of the population in SMC is US-born, and 35% is foreign-born.



Suicides by Marital Status, SMC, 2019-2023




Suicides generally the highest among individuals who are single.

In SMC in 2022 among individuals 15 and older, 52.4% were married, 33.3% were single, 7.9% were divorced, and 4.9% were widowed.



Suicides by Educational Level, SMC, 2019-2023




Over the 5 year time period, there is a shift towards more educated individuals dying by suicide.

In SMC in 2022 among individuals 25 and older, 24.7% HS degree or less, 21.2% had some college or an Associate's degree, 28.7% had a Bachelor's degree, and 25.4% had a Graduate/Professional degree.



Suicides by Method, SMC, 2019-2023



Hanging/suffocation has overtaken firearms as the most common method of suicide in SMC.

Hanging/ Suffocation	46.7%	40.4%	50.0%	36.2%
Poisoning	26.7%	11.5%	22.2%	14.3%

Suicide by firearm is high for males, while suicide by poisoning is high for females. Hanging/suffocation is high for both males and females.

Whites die by suicide by firearm at much higher percentages than Asians and Latinos. Data for Blacks not included due to small numbers.

Suicide by firearm and poisoning have an increasing trend as age increases. Hanging/suffocation has a decreasing trend as age increases. Data not shown for <25 and >84 years of age due to small numbers.



Other Data of Note

- Train-related suicides: possible increasing trend (1/60=1.7% in 2019; 1/79=1.3% in 2020; 2/54=3.7% in 2021; 4/67=6.0% in 2022; 3/65=4.6%; 2/19=10.5% so far in 2024)—these are not among youth
- Sodium nitrite intoxication; 2 cases in 2019; 1 case in 2020; 2 cases in 2023. **All 5 cases were adult males.** A lot of articles in medical journals about this starting in 2022. AB 1109 passed last year to restrict the sale (particularly online) of sodium nitrite in California to youth under the age of 18; takes effect on July 1, 2024.
- 16/65 (~25%) suicides occurred in Daly City in 2023. 7/16 are female—this represents nearly 40% of the female suicides in 2023.



Suicides among Veterans

- 2018: 7/73 = 9.6%
- 2019: 8/60 = 13.3%
- 2020: 9/79 = 11.4%
- 2021: 6/54 = 11.1%
- 2022: 9/67 = 13.4%
- 2023: 4/65 = 6.2%
